

LONDON BOROUGH OF HAVERING
MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES SCHEME

On 19th March 2008, the Council agreed the Members' Allowance Scheme with effect from 1st April 2008. The **Basic Allowance** as then stated was subject to an inflationary uplift in accordance with the annual Local Government Pay Settlement of the Joint Negotiating Committee for Chief Officers of Local Authorities. This has now been agreed and the revised Basic Allowance is shown below. There have been no other changes to the scheme.

Basic Allowance:

An allowance of £10,208 is payable to all Councillors.

Special Responsibility Allowances (SRAs):

In addition to the above, SRAs are payable (in monthly instalments) to the following postholders:

Note:

In accordance with paragraph 4(c) of the Members' Allowance scheme, when a Councillor would otherwise be entitled to more than one special responsibility allowance, then the entitlement shall be to only one, that being the one attracting the higher rate.
