




 In accordance with the National Planning Practice Guidance existing solid buildings within Flood Zone 3b (functional floodplain) should be treated as being within Flood Zone 3a. Additionally areas identified as FZ3b but protected by existing defences or infrastructure should also be treated as FZ3a.
Flood Zone 3b has been based on two sources: the 5% AEP flood extent outlines from the Black's Brook, BIM and Mardyke models or the 'High' NaFRA classification for Emerson Park Stream, Paines Brook and Weald Brook orne


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












