A BRIEF HISTORY OF FAIRKYTES

Originally built in the mid-18th century, the Grade II listed building was once a private house. Several later additions were made up to the end of the 19th century. Previous occupants include Job Alibone, Joseph Fry (son of prison reformer Elizabeth Fry) and Thomas Wedlake, who owned the Iron Foundry which stood opposite. Hornchurch Urban District Council bought Fairkytes in the 1950s and used it as a library. It became the London Borough of Havering's Arts Centre in 1973 when the library moved to a purpose built building in North Street. Over time the centre has grown considerably, incorporating the Annexe building at the rear in 1992 and the Billet building next door in 2001.
