In accordance with the requirements of section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013), Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Havering is about to conduct a review of polling districts and polling places.

The outcome of the review will be reported to the Council to enable the Electoral Registration Officer to make any alterations necessary to the register of electors when it is next revised on 1 December 2019.

Representations from local residents, community groups, organisations, politician and political parties, as well as other locally interested parties are invited to make comments in writing. Any comments should include, where appropriate, alternative venue suggestions that may be used as polling places.

Representations on the existing and proposed arrangements should be made in Writing to the address below by no later than 2 August 2019.
