

Electric Vehicles

Electric vehicles – cars that are powered solely by on-board batteries – are an increasingly attractive travel option for the Havering business community.



Backed by Government, the electric vehicle charge-point network is currently undergoing a rapid expansion throughout the UK to supply the growing number of electric cars on the road.

There are now more than 5,000 public charging points across the country, many of them free of charge. There are over 1,500 in London, rising to 6,000 by 2018.

Key benefits

- Electric vehicles offer major cost savings:
 - A full charge costs between £2 and £3 and gives a typical range of 100 miles – something that would cost between £12 and £18 in a petrol or diesel car

- They are exempt from road tax
- They are eligible for a 100% discount from the London Congestion Charge, worth up to £2,400 a year
- There are fewer mechanical components than conventional vehicles, so servicing costs are likely to be lower
- They have smooth and strong acceleration
- They are almost silent and have no clutch or gears, making them ideal to drive in cities

Plug-in Vehicle Grant

This is available to reduce the higher initial cost of buying an electric vehicle. It provides a subsidy of:

- 25%, **up to £5,000**, towards the cost of an electric car
- 20%, **up to £8,000**, towards the cost of an electric van
