The Excessive extent of hardsurfaced area is inappropriate and visually intrus construction in the street scene and is out of character with and detrimental to the spe character and appearance of this part of the Gidea Park Conversation Area.

Remove from the land all paving, rubble, rubbish and installations brought onto the land in connection with the unauthorised construction. (ii)

Time for compliance: 3 months from the effective date of this notice.

Reinstate the area shown on the attached plan to its former condition reseeding and replacing the affected area with grass. (iii)

Time for compliance: 3 months from the effective date of this notice.

#### WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT 6.

This Notice takes effect on 11th February 2002, unless an appeal is made against i beforehand.
