Carriageway Resurfacing Works – Upminster Road North, Rainham

Repairs and maintenance to Havering's roads and pavements have continued under government guidelines during the COVID-19 pandemic, as this type of work was seen as essential works.

This has helped ensure our roads and pavements are kept safe for NHS and other key workers to travel, during the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the last year, this also included supporting other key services such as deliveries of vital food and medicines to vulnerable residents across the borough, and keeping access routes safe for emergency services.

Together with our contractors Marlborough Highways, who carry out the repairs and maintenance on behalf of the Council, we are also making sure that the crews will continue to observe social distancing and other regulations under guidelines, where they can, in order to remain safe and prevent risk with COVID-19.

Based on the above guidance carriageway resurfacing is planned for the above road during the following date and times: -

Carriageway resurfacing

- **A1306 to Allen Road**
29th / 30th September 2021, 19:30 – 06:00
- **Allen Road to Briscoe Road**
30th September / 1st October 2021, 19:30 – 06:00
- **Briscoe Road to Acer Avenue**
1st / 2nd October 2021, 19:30 – 06:00
- **Acer Avenue to Greenacres Close**
4th / 5th October 2021, 19:30 – 06:00

- **Greenacre Close to Warwick Lane**

5th / 6th and 6th / 7th October 2021, 19:30 – 06:00

During these times, Upminster Road North will be closed in sections to through traffic and diversion routes will be in place to guide vehicles around the works.

Any vehicles wishing to access properties within the closed section, may be required to drive the diversion route, however, there will be traffic marshals located at either end of the road closure to offer the best advice for access, based on individual requirements at any particular moment in time.

For your information, to enable you to plan any required access / egress during the road closure, please find attached a plan of the proposed area of carriageway resurfacing showing the different phases of the resurfacing to be carried out on each night.

Following the completion of the carriageway resurfacing there will be a return visit to apply the high friction surfacing to the following:

Pedestrian crossing adjacent to Lambs Lane north

20th / 21st October 2021, 19:30 – 06:00

This will require traffic to be managed past the working area with the use of temporary two way traffic signals and closures to the side roads within the works area.

When entering the restricted area special care should be taken with regard to Contractor's plant & freshly laid surfacing material. Would you also please ensure that any vehicles belonging to you are not parked in the above section of road whilst the work is in progress?

Should the programme be delayed due to inclement weather or mechanical breakdowns then signs will be erected either end of the street indicating the revised dates.
