Incident Details:

After gaining entry to 14-16 Thames Road, the travellers secured the gate with a chain, while additional vans and trucks continued to arrive, dumping items on the site. Thirty minutes later, my colleagues, including dog handlers and supervisors, arrived for backup. Despite our efforts to halt the trucks' entry, they threatened us to stay out of their path. Engaging with them, they asserted they had families with them and warned of consequences if we interfered. We cautioned them against fly-tipping or further dumping, but they insisted on staying until served with an eviction notice from the county court. We promptly contacted the police again to report the situation. Meanwhile, the travellers affixed a legal warning letter to the door. Despite waiting for hours, the police informed us they couldn't attend that night but would come in the morning. The travellers also covered the main gate with a sheet to conceal their activities inside.
