My Ends- Romford

My Ends

The My Ends Partnership is a MOPAC-led initiative aimed at tackling localised violence in London through community collaboration. The funding focuses on hyper-local interventions in areas of most need.

Currently, the funding has allowed partnerships with Youth Unity, Box Up Crime, and AIR Network. The teams engage with residents aged 7-24 yr olds after school hours offering services like mentoring, boxing and physical activities since September 2024.



The financial investment of £100,000 in Year 1 and £180,000 in Year 2, with strategic oversight from HCSP, utilises local grass roots organisations and capture the views of young people to engage in activities during peak crime hours (3-6pm).









The Romford Unity Hub in Romford Town Centre is a new initiative aimed at providing a safe and supportive space for young people.

The hub was officially launched on January 29th, 2025, with a vibrant mural created by the artist Cize_One in partnership with Havering Council's Community Safety Partnership and Network Rail and funded by the Violence Reduction Unit as part of the MyEnds Program.



Theory of Change Model

Partnerships established with grassroots organisations for sustainable delivery of activities

Provision of positive opportunities for young people to avoid criminal activity Establishment of a model for addressing youth violence that can be replicated in other areas with similar challenges

Overall, the partnership work is positive with organisations supporting one another, being open about any difficulties faced and coming to quick resolutions.
